To fulfill federal requirements, all public-school students must participate in assessments of English language arts and mathematics once during high school. Nevada students in 11th grade participate in the ACT with Writing which provides the required ELA score (representing overall performance on the ACT English, reading, and writing tests) and mathematics score. State administration of the ACT with Writing is scheduled during the school day in the spring. ACT state testing is administered at schools online and/or by paper.
