

FACT SHEET – CRSSA ACT FUNDING

- The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRSSA) Act passed on December 27, 2020.
- Four funding sources for schools: Elementary and Secondary Schools Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER II), Governor’s Emergency Education Relief Funds (GEER II), Center for Disease Control (CDC) Epidemiology Laboratory Capacity (ELC) grant and the SCD Health Disparities Program.
- Washoe County School District received \$34,386,079 under ESSER II. Funds expire 9/30/2023. Washoe is on track to spend down all funds.
- ESSER II Set Asides from NDE – Washoe received \$728,458.
- GEER II Washoe received \$291,391.
