UNDERSTANDING YOUR SCORES

Colleges and universities use ACT and/or SAT scores, or the scores from other required exams (check the admissions requirements for the schools in which you are interested), **to determine your placement in classes**, particularly Math and English. Students not placing at the college level will require support courses in order to meet the prerequisites for college-level classes. Students are encouraged to look at the placement requirements for their potential schools to determine whether or not higher placement exam scores are needed to enroll in college-level courses.

If you wish to retake the ACT or take the SAT, use the information on the back of this handout to plan ahead. It is recommended that students test no later than *December in their senior year* to ensure scores will be available in time to meet important admissions deadlines.

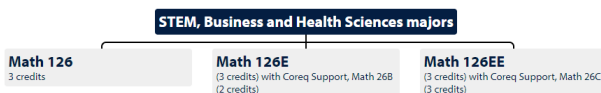

JUNIOR ACT SCORES (All Juniors Tested At GALENA)

JUNIORS - To access your ACT test scores from the test taken by Juniors at Reed in February, you must first create an ACT student account if you don't already have one.
Visit www.act.org and follow the registration steps to create your account.

Important: When creating an ACT account for the first time, you will be asked if you've already registered for and taken an ACT. Select **YES** for both questions to create your online account for the first time. You can then enter your student ACT ID number that was sent in the mail with your ACT test scores. Your test score should merge into your account. If it does not, follow the instructions below.

***Please read below if you do not have your student ACT ID number.**

*Once your online account is created, you must call ACT at 319-337-1270 to have your Junior test scores merged into your account. Tell ACT that you took a state/county ACT test so they can assist you with
