To complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), you will need:

- Your full legal name (as it appears on your birth certificate)
- Your Social Security Number (see the backside of this document if you do not have one)
- Student FSA ID
- Parent FSA ID
- Student Driver's License (if you have one)
 - ✓ Copy of Parent(s) 2023 W-2 form (pictures work fine)
 - ✓ Copy of Parent(s) 2023 Federal Tax Return
 - ✓ Copy of Parent(s) business and investment records
 - ✓ Copy of Student's 2023 W-2 form (if you worked in 2023)
 - ✓ Copy of Student's 2023 Federal Tax Return (if you filed)

In order to receive Federal funds for college, students must fill out FAFSA

First, CREATE an FSA ID by following directions below.

Tips:

- If you have older siblings in college, your parents might already have an FSA ID.
- Only the owner of the FSA ID should create and use the account.
- Never share your FSA ID.
- Parents AND Students MUST have their own FSA ID.
- **IT CAN TAKE UP TO 3 DAYS TO GET VERIFIED. START EARLY.**

Signing up for FSA ID

Step 1 Go to studentaid.gov to get started, click on “Create Account”, then click on “Get Started.”

Step 2 Enter all required information into the form. Make sure to use your note sheet below and keep your information in a safe place.

**If a parent is creating an FSA ID and does not have a SSN:* Please have them mark the box “I don’t have a Social Security Number”- They will then be prompted to include their current mailing address instead. (*Tax ID# will not be collected.*)

Step 3 Review your information and accept the terms and conditions.

Step 4 Confirm your email address and phone number using the secure codes sent to you, which will be sent to the email address and phone number you entered when you created your FSA ID. Once you verify your email address and phone number, you will be able to go back to the FAFSA page and start your FAFSA.

It can take the Social Security Administration up to three days to verify your information. You can still work to complete your FAFSA once it opens, but the automatic tax pull of information may take a while. Parents in this predicament may need to put in their taxes manually.

FSA ID Worksheet- Please keep this page in a safe place. Usernames and passwords will be needed for every year the student is in college until graduation. FAFSA applications usually open October 1st for the following school year.
