**IV/CB VETERANS CLUB** proudly sponsors a continuing education scholarship(s) in the minimum amount of \$1000 for University, Community College, or Trade School-bound seniors participating in JROTC at Incline High School in Washoe County.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Scholarships will be granted to an Incline High School graduating senior in good standing, involved in JROTC and planning on attending an accredited college or trade school. The following criteria must be met:

- Student must be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident graduating from high school.
- Must be accepted and committed to attending an accredited college or trade school by the time of scholarship award.
- Must have participated in the high school JROTC program for at least two years.
- Scholarships will be awarded for full time enrollment in an accredited University, Community College, or Trade School.
- Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate strong leadership skills through JROTC, school activities, church groups, youth groups, community volunteer efforts or related work.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP RULES**

The scholarship is intended for use in the Fall of 2025. The award(s) will be sent directly to the college or university (or given to the student in some cases) and will be given at the end of the student's senior high school year. **APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED BY 5:00 PM, 1 APRIL 2025.**
