### Lake Tahoe College Promise

First-time college students who attend Lake Tahoe Community College full time pay NO tuition for up to 3 years! This Promise is for scholars who wish to complete their Associate degree and or transfer to another college or university within two years, or three if needed for additional coursework and support. The Lake Tahoe College Promise program provides eligible students with the opportunity to combine full-time college attendance with employment and other responsibilities by providing extensive one-on-one support and peer mentoring, a dedicated academic advisor, and much more!

Whether you're 18 or 68, if you are a first-time college student and a California resident or AB540 eligible, or a Nevada resident or Dreamer living in the Tahoe Basin, you may qualify! NOW is the time to pursue your goal of furthering your education and entering a career you've dreamed about.

### **Nevada Promise:**

The Nevada Promise Scholarship is a unique scholarship established by the Nevada Legislature for Nevada high school graduates to attend community college

(TMCC, WNC, or other NEVADA community colleges),

If you are part of the graduating class of 2025, make sure to apply during the application period (August through October) and keep current on the ongoing application steps.

### students must:

- Be classified as a Nevada resident for tuition purposes by the institution where they plan to receive the Nevada Promise Scholarship.
- Have earned High school diploma from a public or private high school located in Nevada; or from a public high school in a county of another state that borders Nevada and accepts Nevada residents;
- Not have earned a prior associate or bachelor's degree.
- Meet all program deadlines. (Check with the college for each step and deadline)
- Enroll in a minimum of 12 semester credit hours in an associate degree program, a bachelor's degree program or a certificate of achievement program for each semester of the school year immediately following the school year in which the student graduates from high school.
