## HOW DO I BECOME A MILLENNIUM SCHOLAR?

Students in the Graduating Classes of 2017\* and later will be eligible when all the following conditions have been met:

- Graduate with a Nevada high school diploma \* \*
- Earn at least a 3.25 GPA (weighted or unweighted) or a qualifying test score \*\*\* (1070 on the SAT or 21 on the ACT)
- Complete the following core curriculum: 4 units in English,
   4 units in Math (including Algebra II or higher),
   3 units in Social Science or History
- Be a Nevada resident for at least two years of their high school career

All requirements must be met by the date of high school graduation.
