

Trade Schools



Advanced Manufacturing

Troubleshoot and control complex interrelated mechanical and electronic control systems and equipment.



Architecture and Design

Designing and constructing physical structures, using creativity and problem-solving.





Career Tech Edu Leadership

Provides a foundation of knowledge for anyone currently, or planning to be, in a training, teaching, supervisory, or leadership role.



Construction Management

Provides students with a greater understanding of the construction industry, as it relates to residential, commercial, and heavy construction markets.



Drafting

A critical skill for a diverse array of industries, drafting is the development of graphic instructions needed to complete a variety of projects.



Machining

A high-tech profession involving preprogrammed computer software to create and manufacture different tools and machinery.

How is College different from High School?

- ► You set your own schedule
 - ► Classes on specific days, flexible times, etc.
- Classes are credit based and different (most 3 credits)
- ▶ 1 credit = amount of time IN class
- Expect to do 1-3 hours of homework OUTSIDE of class per credit
- ► A lot of responsibility on the student to make sure they are in the right class
- You pay for the classes
- ► Typically, you take 4-5 classes a semester
- ▶ Pick new classes every semester ©





Application Day

- ► When: TBA
 - Priority for scholarships, financial assistance, classes/schedule
- ► Where: Here at school, during the school day
- ► What: Apply to colleges during school with the help of the colleges ©
- UNR and TMCC will be here to help, but you can apply anywhere, anytime!

Out of State Colleges & Applications

CommonApp

- Application guide for first-year students (commonapp.org)
- > A means to apply to many different colleges using one application
- Start application process now! See CommonApp for what you will need (i.e. transcripts, test scores, academic achievement, letter of recommendations, etc.)
- College/univeristy must be a part of CommonApp for this to work
 - Double check which schools you want to apply to are on CommonApp or not!
- Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE)
 - > A way to go to an out of state school at a cheaper cost!
 - ➤ May be dependent on your degrees, but almost all are eligible!

- MUST apply for scholarship consideration!
- FREE money for school (grants)
- Loan approval (if needed)
- Open to all U.S. Citizens & eligible noncitizens (come to your counselor for help)
- Hug HS FAFSA Night: TBA! (December- February)

Students Not Eligible for FAFSA
