

Release of Student Directory Information Notice Pictures/Yearbook

You are receiving this notice because you marked "No - I do not consent" for your student's <u>image</u>, <u>voice</u>, <u>and/or name to be used in school publications including but not limited to yearbook, class <u>picture</u>, <u>and school newspaper</u> when you completed you student's Online Enrollment. This means that your student will not be able to be in the classroom picture and yearbook.</u>

Examples of directory information are:

- name
- date and place of birth, photographs
- participation in officially recognized activities and sports
- field of study
- weight and height of athletes
- enrollment status
- degrees and awards received
- dates of enrollment
- most recent previous school attended
- grade level
- grade point average range for college recruitment

According to the Federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, directory information about students may be released by the district without parent consent, provided annual notification has been given and the school does not have on file written denial to release directory information; however, schools do use discretion when they receive requests for directory information and will not release such information if it is the principal's judgment that releasing such information would not be in the best interest of the student.
