


STUDENT BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT PROCESS

 Problem solve with students



Classroom Managed	VS	Office Managed
• Language		• Weapons
• Lateness		• Fighting or aggressive
• Preparedness		• physical contact
• Calling Out		• Chronic minor infractions
• Put Down		• Aggressive language
• Throwing		• Threats
• Refusing to work		• Harassment of student/teacher
• Minor dishonesty		• Major Dishonesty
• Touching		• Truancy
• Tone/Attitude		• Smoking inside the building
• Smoking outside the building (refer to SRO)		• Vandalism (significant)
• Inappropriate comments		• Alcohol
• Electronic devices		• Drugs
• Dress Code		• Gambling
• Food or Drink		

SIDE BAR on Minor Incident Reports Slips

- Issue slip when student does not respond to pre-correction, re-direction, or verbal warning.
- Once written, notify parent with phone call or letter.
- Take concrete action to correct behavior (i.e. assign detention, complete behavior reflection writing, clean desks).
- Whenever possible, have the corrective action(s) correspond to the behavior being corrected.
