











## Q.4: How confident are you in your ability to connect with other parents?




# Q.5: How confident are you in your ability to make sure your child's school meets your child's learning needs?








#### Q.4: How much effort does your child put into schoolrelated tasks?




Q.6: When working on school activities at home, how easily is your child distracted?






#### Q.7: On average, how well does your child work independently on learning activities at home?






Q.1: How much of a sense of belonging does your child feel at his/her school?




#### Q.2: How comfortable is your child in asking for help from school adults?




### Q.3: Given your child's cultural background, how good a fit is his/her school?




Q.4: How well do you feel your child's school is preparing him/her for his/her next academic year?




Q.6: At your child's school, how well does the overall approach to discipline work for your child?






