











Q.4: How confident are you in your ability to connect with other parents?








Q.1: How often does your child read for fun?






Q.4: How much effort does your child put into schoolrelated tasks?




Q.6: When working on school activities at home, how easily is your child distracted?






Q.7: On average, how well does your child work independently on learning activities at home?

Q.2: My child's teacher(s) set high expectations for my child's individual learning.






Q.1: How much of a sense of belonging does your child feel at his/her school?




Q.2: How comfortable is your child in asking for help from school adults?




Q.3: Given your child's cultural background, how good a fit is his/her school?




Q.4: How well do you feel your child's school is preparing him/her for his/her next academic year?



Q.5: How well do the activities offered at your child's school match his/her interests?


