






Q.1: How confident are you that you can help your child develop good friendships?














Q.1: How often does your child read for fun?



Q.2: How often does your child struggle to get organized for school?




Q.3: How often does your child give up on learning activities that s/he finds hard?






Q.4: How much effort does your child put into schoolrelated tasks?



Q.5: How motivated is your child to learn the topics covered in class?




Q.6: When working on school activities at home, how easily is your child distracted?






Q.7: On average, how well does your child work independently on learning activities at home?


Q.8: In general, how well does your child learn from feedback about his/her work?


Q.1: My child is receiving the kind of instruction that is appropriate for his or her abilities.



Q.2: My child's teacher(s) set high expectations for my child's individual learning.




Q.3: My child's teacher(s) provide my child with all of the accommodations needed to do well in his or her classes.










Q.2: My child has at least one staff member at the school in whom they can confide.




Q.3: The rules and expectations for behavior are the same for every student at my child's school.




Q.4: My child is treated fairly by all teachers and staff, no matter his or her race, cultural, or family






Q.1: How much of a sense of belonging does your child feel at his/her school?




Q.2: How comfortable is your child in asking for help from school adults?




Q.3: Given your child's cultural background, how good a fit is his/her school?



Q.4: How well do you feel your child's school is preparing him/her for his/her next academic year?




Q.6: At your child's school, how well does the overall approach to discipline work for your child?




Q.5: How well do the activities offered at your child's

Q.7: How well do the teaching styles of your child's teachers match your child's learning style?






Q.3: My child's school seeks parent input about how to make the school better.
