By the end of the 23-24 school year, the percentage of students scoring on or above grade level in kindergarten through fifth grade at Maxwell Elementary, will increase by 10% as evidenced by the iReady Diagnostic 3 results when compared to Diagnostic 1.

- 2. Monitor attendance vie BIG to ensure that teachers are submitting the Attendance Tracking Sheet on schedule.









Smarter Balanced Assessment Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard




