Student Success Goal

By the next state English Language Arts (ELA) Smarter Balance Assessment (SBAC) exam, increase ELA scores by 5% overall.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

- 1. Regular assessment to determine students' reading levels.
- 2. Focused Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) with discussion around student data using the "Planning Questions and Considerations for PLCs" form.
- 3. Fidelity to the curriculum.
- 4. Instructional schedule that allows for daily small group and intervention blocks.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

Reduce the percentage of chronically absent students by 10%.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

- 1. Develop a system of Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) that includes a variety of positive attendance supports.
- 2. Implement class and school-wide positive reward systems regularly.
- 3. Obtain tangible rewards (e.g., Fly High passes, special lunches, "Star Cart" items).
- 4. Quarterly awards for perfect attendance and most improved attendance.




Smarter Balanced Assessment Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard




