Student Success Goal

In School Year (SY) 2023-24, scholars will earn credit in 85% of all classes taken—up from 70% for which credit was earned in the spring semester of SY2022-23.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

- 1. Review progress grades every two weeks and share data with staff.
- 2. Engage in classroom walk-throughs looking for scholar engagement, academic challenge, and academic vocabulary across the curriculum.
- 3. Record of daily scholar performance in class maintained by classroom teachers.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

Our average percentage of positive responses in the Student Engagement section of the Student Climate survey will increase from 83% in SY 2021 to 95% in SY 2024.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

- 1. We will administer a student survey each quarter asking scholars to respond to the five questions entailed in the Student Engagement section of the Student Climate Survey.
- 2. We will study these results to determine how we adjust to hit our goal of 95% by the end of the year.








2023 Graduation


