Student Success Goals



- 2. The number of 9th grade English Learners (EL) students earning all 3 core credits will rise by 5%
- 3. The number of EL students and students on an IEP who reach proficient level in English Language Arts (ELA) and math on the American College Testing (ACT) will rise by 5%.
- 4. The number of EL students achieving level 3 or 4 on the Science Assessment will rise by 5%.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

- 1. Use Lancers Excel to provide students with targeted intervention on foundational skills that will help them meet learning goals.
- 2. Pull 9th graders who need additional supports in math to work with Algebra 1 teachers.
- 3. Provide EL and IEP students with additional instruction in test-taking skills and vocabulary development prior to taking the ACT.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

School Goal: The percentage of students who report feeling that they are a part of McQueen will increase to 75% (from 67%).

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

- 1. Identify and share with teachers social and emotional learning practices that can be embedded in classroom instruction and environment.
- 2. Teach Social Emotional Learning (SEL) lessons during Freshman Seminar to improve students' interpersonal skills, such as problem-solving, conflict resolution, self-control, communication, negotiation, sharing, and good manners. Other skills that could be taught include listening, stress management, and decision-making.
- 3. Create more opportunities for students to voice their concerns and ideas about activities at McQueen.








2023 Graduation
