Student Success Goal

Each student will receive a plan to build transitional skills that will assist them in preparing them for the Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) of their future.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

- 1. Transitional skills will be shown on individual students' point sheets and will be used to inform staff intervention decisions.
- 2. Staff will accurately mark points for transitional skills satisfactorily demonstrated and will be reviewed and used to inform success levels achieved by 100% of students.
- 3. Staff will consistently log minor behaviors in Infinite Campus (IC) to inform planning decisions.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

Turning Point will prioritize positive parent contact as measured by parent contact log and parent climate data and will increase the number of parent responses by 50%.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

- 1. Ensure IC contacts are up to date.
- 2. Teachers will develop a systematic plan for reaching the parents of students in their advisories.
- 3. Parents will be encouraged by personal invitation to complete Climate Survey.
- 4. Regularly remind parents that a computer kiosk is available for them to come in and use.


