# What is a Signature Academy?

- A Signature Academy is a specialized high school program that focuses on a career path and/or area of study.
- Signature Academies are offered at most high schools in WCSD.
- Students in 8<sup>th</sup> grade can apply to attend a Signature Academy at any high school in the District based on their personal interests.

- Why should students consider a Signature Academy?
  - Most Signature Academies provide <u>Career Technical Education (CTE)</u> programs
  - These programs provide students the opportunity to:
    - Explore career paths
    - Develop leadership and workforce readiness skills
    - Connect with local businesses and organizations
    - Earn college credit and/or job certifications
    - Apply hands-on learning in areas such as agriculture, business, engineering, human and social services, medicine, skilled trades and technology
  - Signature Academies are a great way to study something that interests you while preparing you for life after high school!





## Can anyone attend a Signature Academy?

- All interested 8<sup>th</sup> graders are encouraged to apply!
- It is recommended that students demonstrate:
  - A 2.0 GPA or above in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade
  - Grade-level performance on standardized tests (i.e. SBAC, MAPS)
  - History of generally acceptable attendance and behavior
- If students cannot demonstrate the above qualifications, they may be found ineligible for enrollment to a Signature Academy





- What happens if I apply but I'm found ineligible to attend a Signature Academy?
  - You can have your parent/guardian request a second opportunity (appeal) to have your application reviewed and determine if there is good reason to make an exception, <u>OR</u>
  - You can ask your middle school counselor about enrolling in a Career
    Technical Education course / program at your zoned high school in 9<sup>th</sup>
    grade





#### How can I apply to attend a Signature Academy?

- Ask your counselor for help, <u>OR</u> visit

  There are 3 opportunities to turn in your application, but don't wait to apply! Space may run out in each of the application rounds shown below:
  - Round 1: November 15<sup>th</sup> January 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Round 2: February 15<sup>th</sup> March 15<sup>th</sup>
  - Round 3: April 1<sup>st</sup> 2 weeks before start of the next school year









- How does transportation to a Signature Academy work?
  - If you are accepted as a student to a Signature Academy, you will have to provide your own transportation, except for AACT and Wooster
  - AACT and Wooster provide busing to students who need it
- Can I attend a Signature Academy at the high school I'm zoned for?
  - Absolutely. It's the same process for applying.





### How do sports work at a Signature Academy?

- Students who attend AACT can still participate in sports at their zoned high school.
- A student attending any other Signature Academy is eligible to participate in sports at that school only.

- Hug: Health and Human Services (Human Development, Culinary Arts, Baking, and Pastry; Sports Medicine)
