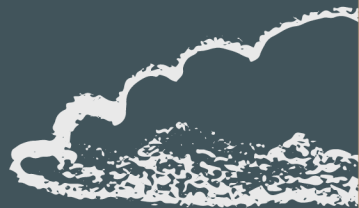

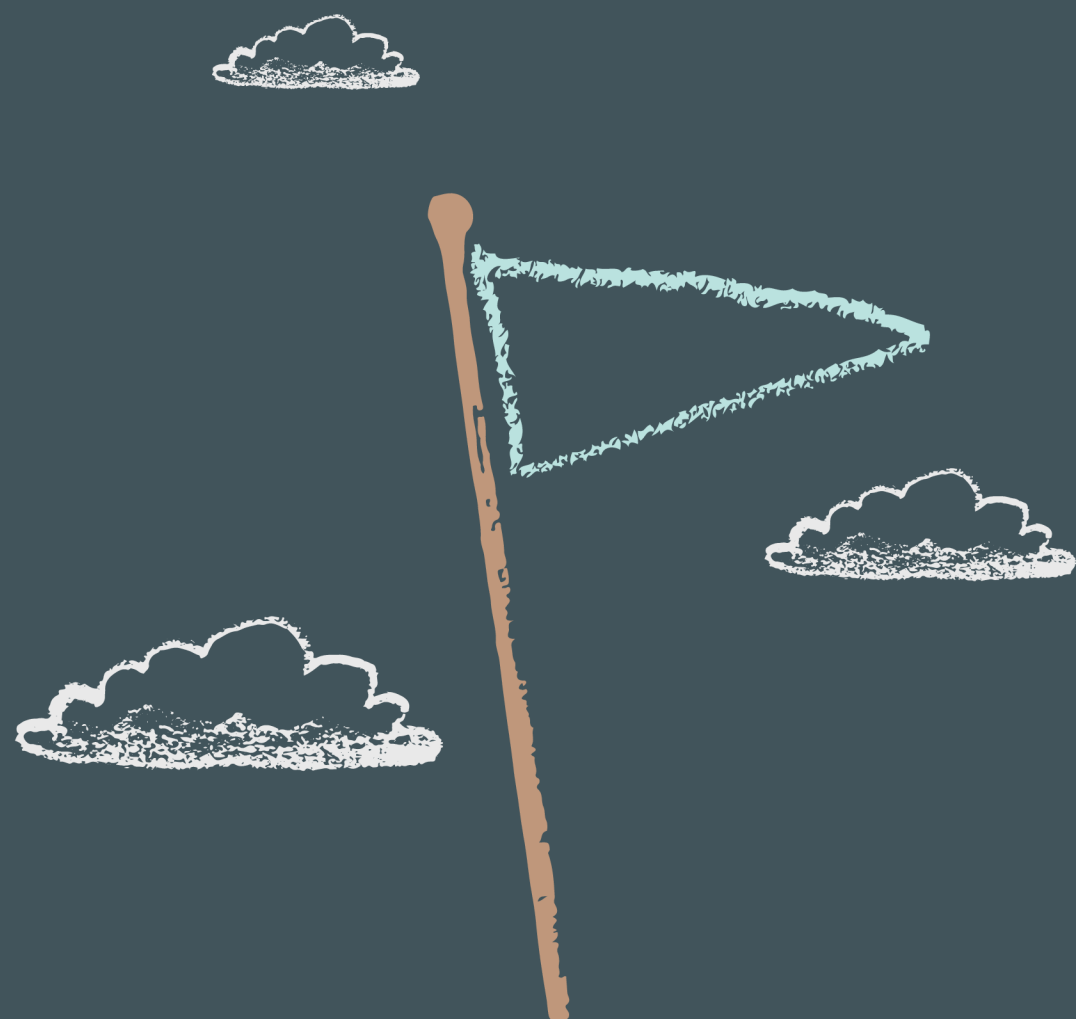


Our Mission

All students will take an introductory music class next year-

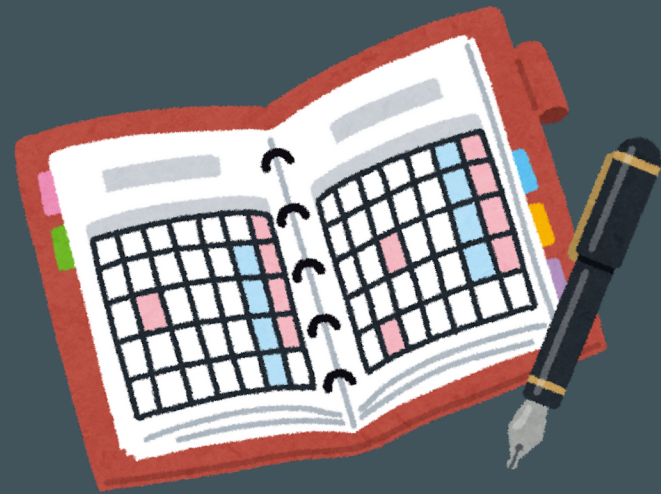

All families were asked to register **ONLINE** to choose their child's music elective class.

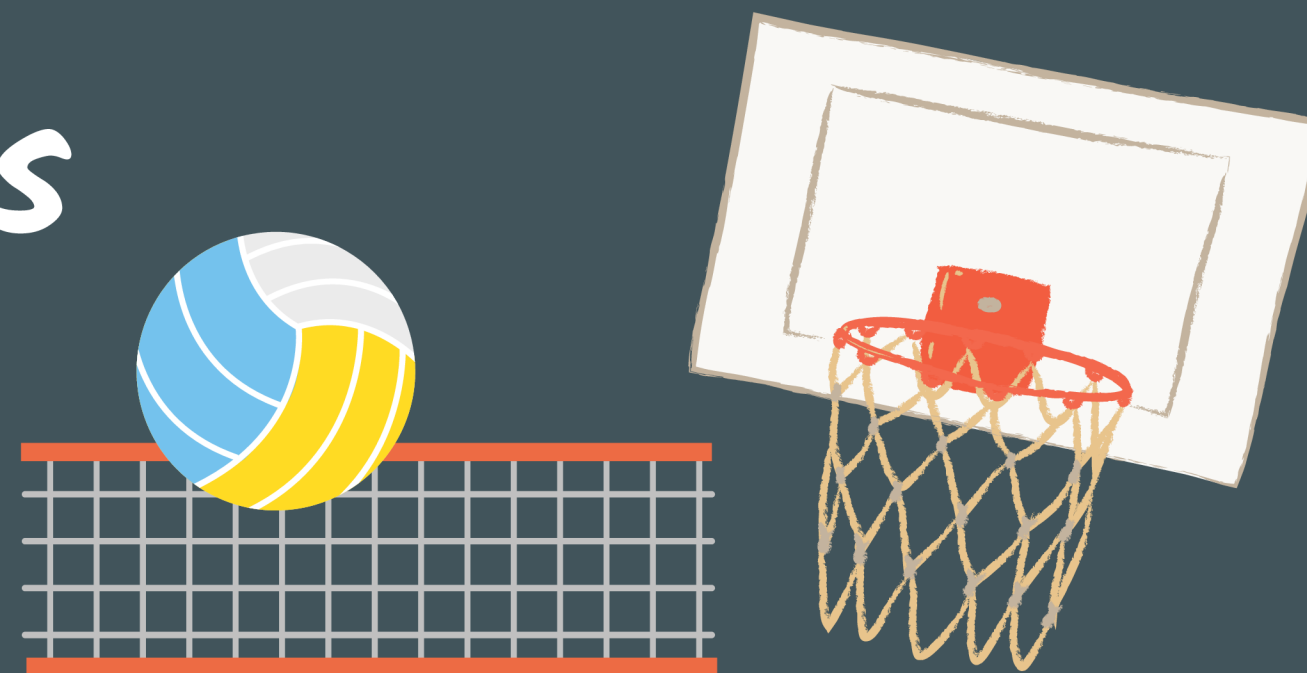
