- Congratulations to all of our Track and Field athletes who competed in Las Vegas at the State Meet. Eleanor Raker and Gioia Coudriet finished first and second in the 1600m and 3200m. Eleanor also medaled in the very competitive 800m with a strong 3rd place finish. Carter Rockwell and Nathan Bronander finished 2nd and 4th in the long jump. Both athletes PRd with Carter setting a new school record with a jump of 23'7.5". Carter also placed 2nd in the triple jump. Stone Rasmussen finished 3rd in the 110m hurdles. Alyssa Dixon set a new school record with her fourth place finish in the 100m. She ran a blazing 12.15 with five hundredths of a second separating first from fourth place finish. Alyssa placed 2nd in the long jump, and third in the 200m. Elijah Sipaila finished a strong fifth in the 300m hurdles. Cohen Hughes vaulted 13'0" contributing points to the boy's team. Braydon Landon and Thomas Hubbell high jumped uphill and into a head wind, scoring more points for the team. Matthew Rittenhouse, the second person in the history of Galena to break 50 seconds in the 400m lead our 4x400m relay along with Hunter Steele, David Coisson, and Tyler Estipona to earn 3 points for Galena. He also was part of the 4x100m relay with Erik Rodriguez, Nathan Bronander and Ryan Tam which scored another 3 points. Hunter Steele and David Coisson finished third and fourth in the 1600m. Hunter finished third in the hotly contested 800m. Ayden Mosby competed in the 3200m running a 9:53. Our boys 4x800 with Kole Steele, Ayden Mosby, Cayden Mosby, and Tyler Estipona ran a great race, barely edged out of medal contention by Gorman, and our ladies 4x800 with Lauren Leverty, Raija Burst, Avery Hunt and Juliet Cuddy ran a solid race earning points for the Lady Grizzlies. Our Ladies 4x400m team, Ella Walker, Gaby Oberg, Panda Ruvalcab and Alyssa Dixon ran a great race to earn 4 points and close out the meet as well as a successful year for our Track and Field teams.
