- **PSAT Test Information for Sophomores and Juniors**

As we approach the end of the school year, we want to let you know that sophomores and juniors will have the opportunity to take the PSAT/NMSQT at school this October. More detailed information will be shared in the fall.

The test is **free for sophomores** as a practice experience, and **juniors will pay only \$18**. For juniors, this test is especially important as it is the only pathway to qualify for National Merit Scholarships—a valuable opportunity for students.

If your student is interested in preparing over the summer, free online practice resources are available through the Washoe County Library. Additionally, Khan Academy offers excellent SAT practice sessions and full-length tests that can help them get ready.

**Galena Clinic - Important Information from Galena Health Office regarding vaccine requirements for the 2025-2026 School Year:**

**Religion Exemptions – New Form Needed Every School Year:** Students who currently have a religious immunization exemption form on file **must renew the form every school year** per Nevada state law. The religious exemption form is attached for your convenience.

AND ALSO:

**ATTENTION INCOMING 12<sup>TH</sup> GRADE STUDENTS:** Immunization requirement for 12<sup>th</sup> grade entry. All incoming senior students are required by Nevada State Law to have at least one dose of MCV4 (MenACWY vaccine for Meningitis) on or after 16 years of age.
