

# Concert Reminder

- WHAT:** Fall Concerts!
- WHO:** All Depoali Beginning and Intermediate Orchestra Students
- WHERE:** Depoali Middle School Cafetorium
- WHEN:** Wednesday, October 2, 2024  
**6th Grade Beginning Orchestra** 5:00pm Call 4:50pm  
**Intermediate Orchestra** 7:00pm Call 6:50pm
- ARRIVE:** 5 minutes before your *Call* time (see above)
- BRING:** Your instrument. 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> also bring your music.
- DRESS:** **6<sup>th</sup> Grade** – Orchestra t-shirt, blue jean long pants, shoes of your choice.  
**7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade** – Orchestra polo, all black *dress* pants, all black socks, **ALL** black *dress* shoes.
- NOTE 1:** T-shirts & polos will be passed out during class on October 1 and 2. Please make sure you have paid your class fee which includes your uniform shirt. You can ask in the Depoali Office if you have paid your class fee.
- NOTE 2:** **7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade, if you do not own appropriate concert attire** (pants, socks, shoes), you will need to talk to Ms. Karl during lunch **before Friday, September 27**, so she can arrange for you to get the appropriate clothes. Inappropriate clothes for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades include but are not limited to: yoga pants jeggings, athletic pants of any kind, pants of any kind that are not all black, tennis shoes, athletic shoes of any kind, combat boots, Crocs, Uggs, or shoes of any kind that are not **ALL** black.
- NOTE 3:** **Intermediate Orchestra** will have an after-school rehearsal on Tuesday, October 1 from [Intermediate Orchestra after school rehearsal cancelled as of 9/30] the alternate [ ] drawer for your class period before the end of school on Tuesday, October 1, 2024.

**CELLOS & BASSES:** Bring your home instrument to school on Friday, September 27.

Concerts are part of the overall grade. You must sign in at the concert. If you do not, you will need to see Ms. Karl during lunch to complete an alternate assignment proving you attended the concert. Pictures and videos of you at the concert or emails from a parent *do not* qualify as the alternate assignment.

*If you are unable to attend the concert*, you must complete the alternate assignment on the reverse and turn it into the orchestra drawer for your class period before the end of school on the concert date, **Wednesday, October 2, 2024**.
