Class Rules & Student Responsibilities

Class Rules

- 1. Act mature. This is Middle School.
- 2. Listen to the teacher and your peers (NO talking or playing).
- 3. Remain seated. Do not follow Ms. Karl around the room.
- 4. Only touch what is yours. This includes other people they do not belong to you.
- 5. No electronics, food, drinks (including water), candy, or gum.

Depoali school rules apply in the orchestra room. Ms. Karl follows the Depoali Middle School Student Behavior Management Process as outlined by administration in the student planners. Most students will only need occasional redirections or reminders to follow the rules.

Students who require multiple redirections and/or reminders to follow the above rules will have earned the following consequences:

- A minor referral will be entered into IC
- Behavior grade will be lowered to zero points for that day.
- Students will serve a 15-minute detention at the beginning of the lunch.
 - Lunch detention will be served in the location indicated by Ms. Karl (ie. the orchestra room, or other school room hosting lunch detention).
 - A self-reflection assignment will be completed during lunch detention and turned in to Ms. Karl. Ms. Karl will then share the student's self-reflection with the student's parents.
- Students who do not show up to lunch detention will be referred to Depoali administration.
- Students who do not change behavior after the above actions will be referred to Depoali administration.

Student Responsibilities

- Be on time to class.
- Show common human decency. Follow S.T.R.I.K.E.
- Be an ACTIVE participant in your own education.
- Keep your area clean.
- Practice at home a little each day.
- Take good care of your instrument and bow.
- Ask your teacher for help whenever you need it.
- Take pride in the fact that you can make music!
