## **Infinite Campus**

Infinite Campus (IC) is the primary mode of communication used by Ms. Karl throughout the year. Please make sure your contact information is correct in IC and your settings indicate you can receive emails from Depoali teachers. If you notice errors or are unsure, please call the Depoali Main Office (775-852-6700).

Below are some tips to help you show responsibility and understand your grades:

- Check each assignment in IC not just your overall grade.
- Look to see if the teacher entered any comments for the assignment. Comments entered by teachers can help students understand why they earned the grades they did on specific assignments.
- Ms. Karl adds comments for most assignments that earn a grade below 80%. The comments will be notes on why
  students earned the grades they did so they can work to improve for the next time.

## Infinite Campus Codes

- **0** = Counts as final grade of 0%. This grade cannot be changed by student work.
- **Ch** = Cheated Indicates the student cheated on this assignment. This counts as a final grade of 0%. This grade cannot be changed by student work.
- **Dr** = Dropped Indicates that the score for this assignment has been dropped from calculation as part of the student's overall grade. This is typically not used in middle school and is never used by Ms. Karl.
- I = Incomplete Indicates the assignment was turned in but the student did not follow directions and so the assignment is incomplete
- L = Late Indicates that students turned in the work past the due date. The grade may be penalized by up to 20% according to Depoali policy.
- **M** = Missing Counts as 0%. Usually this grade can be changed when missing work or late work is turned in as long as it is turned in before the late work due date.
- T = Turned In Indicates that the student turned in the assignment. The teacher may or may not have had time to grade and enter a score for that assignment. Unless accompanied by a score, this code does not count for or against the overall grade.
- **X** = Exempt This is very rare, reserved only for extenuating circumstances. It means students are exempt (excused) from that assignment. This grade does not count for or against the overall grade.
