TRIP DATE CHANGE:

Trip Overview:

Depoali Intermediate Band students are preparing for a special field trip opportunity on Friday, May 16, 2025. At school in the morning that day, we will have a clinic with a guest conductor to help us prepare for Band Festival the following week. After our clinic, we will head to Coconut Bowl as a reward for our work this year. The Coconut Bowl reward comes at a discounted rate of \$40 per student for an all-access package (*includes: bowling (limited lanes), mini golf, laser tag, go-karts, High Ballocity, XD theater, billiards, and 40 arcade tickets*). I will also be providing lunch for the students using the money we earned from our Donation Drive this Fall. Students can also bring money to buy other snacks and more arcade tokens. Below you will see the itinerary and expectations of the field trip. I am excited to provide this opportunity to our band students!

Eligibility- all students must meet the following criteria to attend Coconut Bowl:

- Passed all classes in quarter 3 and be passing all classes in quarter 4. NOTE: Any student who failed any 3rd quarter class will have to complete grade checks (see reverse) showing 70% or higher in all classes and have approval from all of your teachers. This grade check will be due on April 18 (Friday), April 25 (Friday), May 5 (Monday) and May 12 (Monday).
- No major referrals or suspensions in quarter 4.
- No unverified or truant absences. Truant means the student skipped class. Unverified means the parent did not notify the school of the student's absence. To avoid these types of absences, students should attend all classes and make sure parents notify the school of absences.

Registering for the trip-please complete the following by Friday, April 25:

- Complete the WCSD Student Travel Permission & Liability Waiver (attached to this form and also linked on the band website)
- Send in \$40 payment. Make checks to Depoali MS (Credit in the student's music account can be applied to this trip). You can also pay this online by logging into Infinite Campus (this is a new option!).

Chaperones

All volunteers and chaperones must physically visit the school office to complete WCSD's volunteer form and submit their driver's license as proof of identify. There is no cost to the chaperone, unless you want to participate in the activities listed in the Trip Overview. In that case, the cost is \$40.
