 - Figure costs for activities/ice cream treats/tips and tax on purchases
 - Give your students a budget and let them plan a day for the family!
 - Home projects have students calculate the amount of paint needed, or wood for decking, etc.
 - \circ Out of town –

- Have your student calculate gas/mpg/times for arrival, etc.
 - Rates are an important real-world skill!
 - Look at and evaluate the architecture at your location
 - Find repeated patterns in art, nature, and science!
