- ▶ Please wait until you **hear the bell** to be dismissed from class.

Off and Away!!!!!!

- ▶ **CELL PHONES- WE DON'T WANT TO SEE THEM OR HEAR THEM DURING SCHOOL HOURS**
- ▶ **Cell phones** should be in your locker, or your binder during school hours: 7:23-2:00 pm. Not in your back pocket, please. ;-)
- ▶ Teachers will **NOT** ask you to use your phone for any purpose.

Meals at Mendive

- ▶ **First lunch:** 8th, Team Fleck, Wilson, .
- ▶ **Second lunch:** 6th grade, Team Goedert, Lawrence,

Breakfast and Lunch will be **FREE** for all students. Have your **student ID** number ready and be prepared to order when you get to the front.

Please sit at your designated table & refer to the Cafeteria PP for further info

When in the lunch line, be respectful and do not skip the line.

Throw out your garbage when done eating, please.

If you are not eating- go directly outside via the **MUSIC HALLWAY**.

Recess:

- ▶ After you have thrown out your trash you may go outside to play in the field, on the basketball courts, or on the hardtop.
- ▶ **Balls are available to check out with your school ID.**
- ▶ Exit through the music hallway, enter through the doors you enter in the mornings. ***Both sets of doors will be open. Enter the door closest to your locker.***

When you hear the **bullhorn siren** it is time to come in. You have 5 minutes to get to your next class.



Lunch time passes:

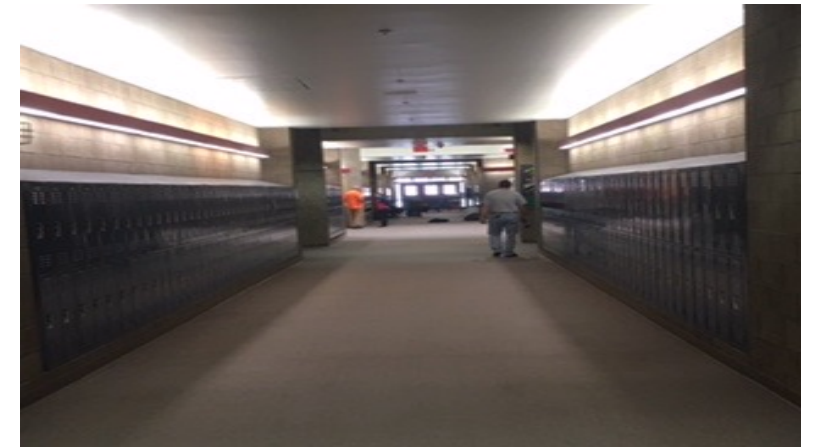
- ▶ What to do at lunch time if you don't want to go outside:
 - stay in cafeteria quietly until asked to leave
 - get a pass from a teacher to spend time in his/her room- eat afterwards- **NO food in the hallways**
 - get a pass to the library to read quietly or do homework
- ▶ **You MUST have a pass from a teacher or the librarian to be in the hallways during lunch time. No PASS, No entry to the hallways**



Lockers and the Hallway:



- ▶ Locker areas are tight. Please be courteous to your locker buddies above, below, and on either side of you.
- ▶ **Locker times-4 times per day:** before advisory, before & after lunch, & after school. No one is to be at their lockers DURING CLASS or between periods. ALL binders should be in your locker **BEFORE** going to lunch.
- ▶ Hallways will be crowded. Be respectful of those around you. Stay on the **RIGHT** side of the hallway to avoid traffic jams. Keep hands & feet to yourself.
- ▶ You **MUST** use a hall pass when leaving class.
- ▶ You only have **3 MINUTES- HUSTLE!!**



Uniforms

SHIRT OPTIONS:

- ▶ Mendive collared shirt or a black, grey, or purple collared plain shirt- no logos
- ▶ ***T-shirts are not uniform approved.*** Your shirt must have a collar.
- ▶ Mendive grey or purple sweatshirt or a black, grey, purple, white non-hooded sweater or sweatshirt

BOTTOMS OPTIONS:

- ▶ Black pants, shorts, skirts, sweats- no logos or rips above thighs
- ▶ Grey pants, shorts, skirts, sweats- no logos or rips above thighs
- ▶ Khaki pants, shorts, skirts, sweats- no logos or rips above thighs

OUTERWEAR:

- ▶ Must be in your locker. No hoodies, jackets, hats, etc...

7th and 8th Entering/Exiting the building

- ▶ 7th & 8th grade students will enter the building in the morning using the doors located on the West side of the building; the blacktop where the field is located.
- ▶ Once you have your locker, use the door that gets you to your locker the quickest.
- ▶ You may exit either of these doors after school and enter either set of doors at lunch.
- ▶ Students eating **BREAKFAST** can enter using the main entrance. Once you have cleaned up your garbage, exit using the main entrance to the black top. **NO FOOD OUTSIDE.**



6th grade Entering/Exiting the building

- ▶ 6th grade students will enter the building in the morning using the doors located on the North side (**Del Rosa**) of the building. The doors to the right of the library entrance.
- ▶ You may use these doors after school as well or use any other exit except the main doors.
- ▶ Students eating **BREAKFAST** can enter using the main entrance. Once you have cleaned up your garbage, exit using the main entrance to the black top. **NO FOOD OUTSIDE.**



Ground Transportation:

- ▶ Students are allowed to ride their scooters, skateboards, & bicycles to school. ONCE you are on school property, you must **WALK** your implement to the bicycle rack. This is a safety issue.
- ▶ Mendive is **NOT** responsible for lost or stolen items. Please lock up your possessions.
- ▶ ***NO items are allowed in the school building.*** Please respect our safety rules.
- ▶ Scooters and skateboards are a PRIVILEGE, not a RIGHT. Don't lose this opportunity.



Buses:



- ▶ Please check the WCSD webpage to find your drop off & pick up times & locations.
- ▶ Note your **bus number**. It will be the same bus number to & from school unless otherwise indicated by the driver or the webpage.
- ▶ At times, your bus may break down. In that case, the replacement bus will be in the same bus lane # as usual. Lane #8 is closest to the school. Buses park in the same lane number every day. Check the lane number when are dropped off.
- ▶ **Riding a bus is a PRIVLEDGE, not a RIGHT.** Obey all bus rules, be polite, and courteous.

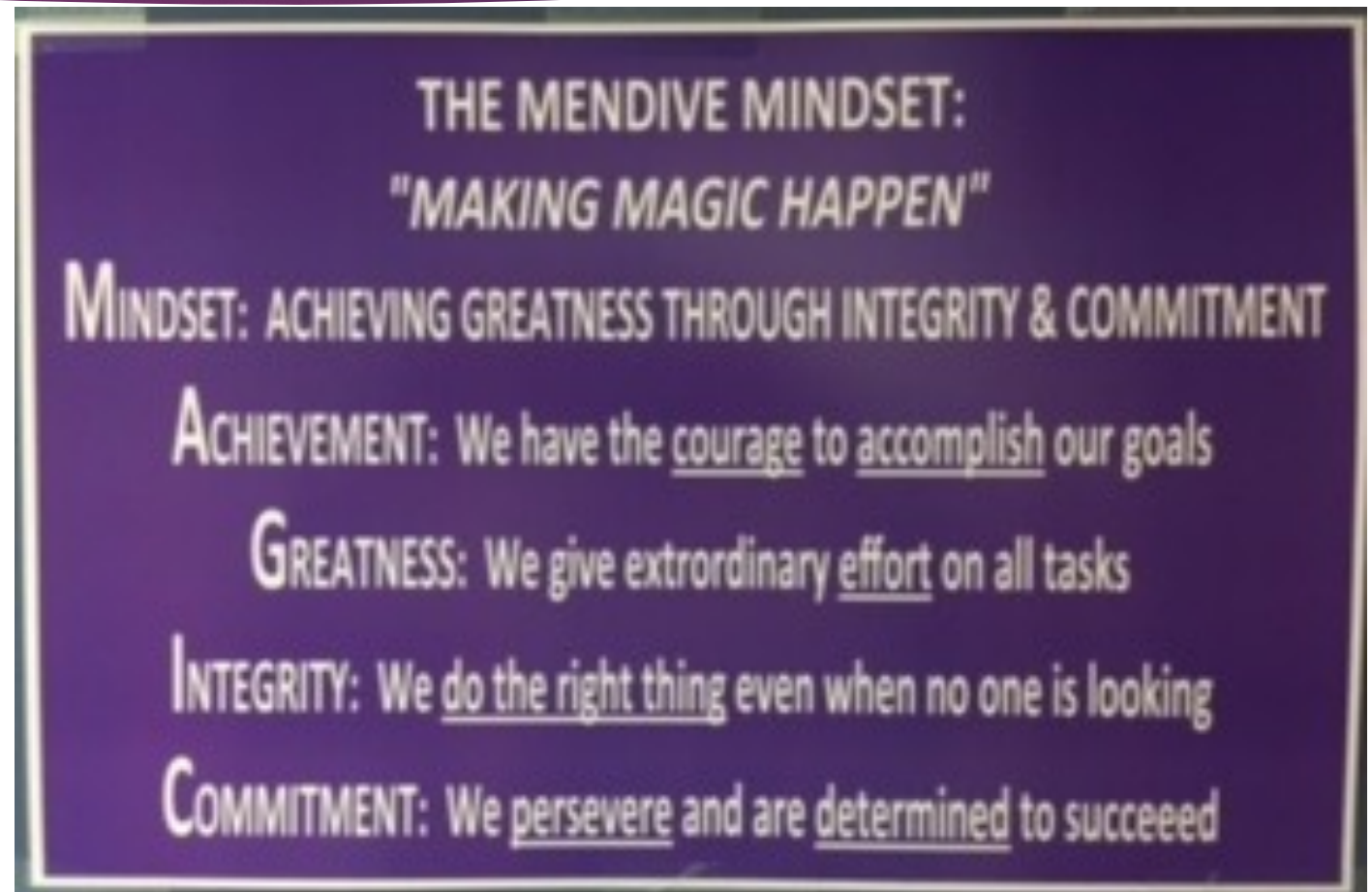


The Agenda Book:
