How Do You Enroll in Signature Programs?

Eighth grade students wishing to participate in a Signature Program apply for admission in the fall of their 8th grade year. Current 9th and 10th grade students may apply for a Signature Program during the annual School-of-Choice application window. For Signature programs where qualified applicants outnumber available spaces, a random lottery process will be used for enrolling students. Applications will be available from each high school.

Qualifications for Signature Program Eligibility

Eligibility for enrollment in a Signature Program is based on qualifications set by WCSD that demonstrate a student's commitment to academic success, and these are determined by an average of performance in the 7th and 8th grade year. Information to determine eligibility will be taken from WCSD Infinite Campus records; for students not currently enrolled in WCSD, applicants must provide 7th and 8th grade transcripts, behavior records, attendance records, and their most recent standardized test results in Math and Reading to the school they are applying to attend. Because of the rigorous coursework of our Signature Programs, it is recommended that students meet the following expectations to be successful:

- GPA: Recommended 2.0 overall GPA in core classes (English, Math, Science, and Social Studies); failing grades are not recommended
- Standardized Test Scores: Recommended "Meets or Exceeds Standards" on standardized tests taken in 7th and 8th grades
- Attendance: Regular school attendance (a minimum of 90% is encouraged)
- Self-Management: Demonstration of appropriate self-management abilities while in middle school is recommended
- Major documented behaviors in Infinite Campus will be screened prior to admission

Transportation

Bussing is available for three WCSD Signature Schools – AACT (Academy of Arts, Careers & Technology), Debbie Smith CTE Academy, and Wooster High School. Students accepted to these schools can access a school bus near their zoned high school or other school, and should check with AACT, Debbie Smith, and Wooster for details. Parents must provide transportation to the bus pick up and drop off location, as schedules will not allow for door-to-door service. Students who are accepted at all other WCSD Signature Programs are responsible for their own transportation to/from the school. No transportation will be provided.

Athletics Participation

Students accepted at AACT (Academy of Arts, Careers & Technology) or Debbie Smith CTE Academy are eligible to participate in athletics at their zoned HS, if the sport is not offered. Students accepted in Signature Programs at all other schools are eligible to participate in athletics at the school they will attend. Non-zoned students in a Signature Program may participate in any NIAA sanctioned sport offered at that school at any level other than varsity for the first year.
