Student Success

School Goal 1: Kate Smith will improve student achievement in ELA and Math as measured by student growth in alignment with the WCSD Performance Framework and the Nevada School Performance Framework (NSPF). Ensure that all students have access to high quality Tier 1 instruction focused on grade level language arts and mathematical skills. Due to the many implications of COVID-19, Kate Smith was unable to complete the 2020-21 school year in a traditional manner which directly impacted achievement levels for our student population. We expect to grow 5% of students meeting the proficiency threshold based formative common assessments and SBAC in ELA.
