Required Classes for 9th Graders

- Number of Classes Required for Freshman: 7
 - English
 - English 1-2 or Honors 1-2 only options
 - Math
 - Science
 - Frosh Seminar
 - Required of all 9th graders- NO EXCEPTIONS
 - + 3 additional elective classes

(Should consider PE/Military Science, Music, Computer Science and Applications/Health, Foreign Lang., etc. for last 3 classes)

Math

Currently in Math 8 - Algebra 1- For all students

Currently in Algebra 1- There are 2 Choices:

- Retake Algebra 1
- All students earning a C, D or F in <u>ANY</u> of the first 3 quarters in Alg 1, are strongly encouraged to retake Algebra 1 in 9th grade
- Formal Geometry (H)

Students need to earn an A or B for the first 3 quarters of Algebra 1

Currently in Geometry

• Take Formal Geometry (H)

- Take Algebra II (H):
 - Earn an A for the first 3 Qrts of Formal Geometry

Unless you plan on taking a math class your senior year at UNR/TMCC, this may not be the recommended route

• 4 years of math is recommended

Science

- Freshman 3 options
- Advanced selection is concurrent with Math Course selection

- Biology or Honors Biology (Algebra I or above)
- Honors Chemistry (Algebra II H)

Foreign Language

- Spanish 1-2 or 3-4
- French 1-2

- Students should have earned an A or B BOTH semesters in 8th grade to take Spanish 3-4
 - ➤ If you don't plan on taking Spanish 5-6 your Sophomore year, it is advised to retake Spanish 1-2
 - > Spanish 1-2 will NOT automatically show on the high school transcript

Elective Classes

- Mixed Choir (Can be taken for a full year or only a semester-Sem/Yr)
- Music Appreciation (Sem)
- Digital Music (Sem)
- Speech/Debate (requires time commitment outside of school)

- Art 1-2 (Sem/Yr)

• PE Team Sports (Sem or Yr)

• Power Walking (Sem or Yr)

Basketball Class (Sem or Yr)

Students interested in taking Weight Training MUST have Teacher approval. All students will sign up for PE.

Military Science I

- Successful completion of semesters 1-4 satisfies P.E. requirement through an exemption
- Successful completion of semester 5 satisfies the Health requirement
- Successful completion of semester 5-6 satisfies the Art/Humanities requirement

This program offers many extracurricular opportunities as such as rifle team and robotics

Exceptions for Required Credits

- P.E. Exemptions:
 - P.E. exemptions can be earned by participation on any R.H.S. athletic team or Cheerleading (A .5 credit exemption earned per season)
 - Extended Studies also has PE Options exemptions available
 - Other PE options are available through BYU

Red House Project (RHP) Classes

Students MUST fill out an application on the Signature Academy Website

- Civil Engineering
- Computer Science
- Graphic Design
- Health Sciences I (Sports Medicine Program)
- Media Communications

Red House Project Application

Interested students **MUST** fill out an application located on the RHS Counseling website OR the RHS Red House Project Website (Deadline Thursday, February 6th)

- Each program has a limited number of seats
 - Placement into RHP Program is based on a lottery draw
 - If student acquires a seat in the program, it will appear on their schedule in the fall as one of their elective class choices
- Students are required to complete the 2 years minimum in that pathway course
- Students should list their intended pathway on their course request form for one of their elective choices
