





## Poetry Terms Exploration Analysis



### SPECIFIC THEME:

Overcoming the odds requires discipline

#### POEM TITLE: "Hall of Fame"

What is the poem about? (one sentence)

You will find success if you believe in yourself, don't give up, & do what makes you happy.

#### Mood/Tone:

I chose the color yellow because of the uplifting tone in the song. Yellow also represents light and this song is about being a light for others.

### SPECIFIC THEME:

Challenge brings strength

#### POEM TITLE: "It's not over yet"
