

Community Service

Students may earn a ½ elective credit by submitting evidence of 60 hours of community service. A description of the intended community service must be submitted to Extended Studies for preapproval three weeks prior to the proposed experience. Students must submit a report addressing the benefit of their experiences at the conclusion of the class. (Fee: \$50 per ½ credit; S/U grade awarded).).

Supervised Curriculum Physical Education (SCPE)

Students may earn a ½ PE credit

per semester by participating in an approved preprofessional/competitive sport. Students must log 60 hours of active participation within the semester. Students must complete a final project at the conclusion of the semester.

(Fee: \$75 per ½ credit; S/U grade awarded).

Physical Education (PE) Options

Students may earn a ½ PE credit per semester by taking group classes at an approved fitness facility. Students must participate in 60 hours of scheduled group classes taught by a certified instructor (video classes are not accepted) within the semester to earn credit. Students must complete a final project at the conclusion of the semester. (Fee: \$75 per ½ credit; S/U grade awarded).
